The Babadook, directed by Jennifer Kent, was screened. This psychological horror film cleverly uses supernatural elements to explore themes of grief, motherhood, and female resilience. Next, Moana, a Disney animated film directed by Ron Clements and John Musker, brought an empowering story of courage and self-discovery. Offside, an Iranian film directed by Jafar Panahi, which highlights gender discrimination in sports. The film portrays a group of young Iranian women who disguise themselves as men to sneak into a football stadium where female spectators are banned. This satirical yet poignant film shed light on the barriers women face in male-dominated spaces and sparked a conversation on gender equality in sports and beyond.

The Eco Dame Eiga Fest was not just a celebration of cinema but also a platform for dialogue, reflection, and awareness, reinforcing the importance of gender inclusivity and empowerment through the lens of storytelling. Each film in the festival contributed to an enriching dialogue, offering diverse perspectives on women's roles, struggles, and empowerment in different socio-cultural contexts. Eco Dame Eiga Fest successfully created a space for

reflection, debate, and awareness on gender-related issues through the powerful medium of cinema.
